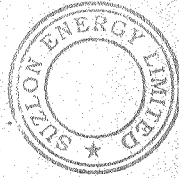

Suzlon Group wins 22 MW repeat order from Sri Kumarswamy Mineral Exports Private Limited.

- Order comprises Suzlon's S88 and S66 make turbines
- Project to be commissioned in Tamil Nadu by end of FY13
- Project takes SKMEPL's wind portfolio to 51 MW

Pune: Suzlon Group, the world's fifth leading* and India's largest wind turbine manufacturer has signed a contract for a 21.75 MW project with Sri Kumarswamy Mineral Exports Private Limited (SKMEPL), Bellary. The project comprises nine units of Suzlon's S66 – 1.25 MW and five units of Suzlon's S88 – 2.1 MW wind turbines. The project is set to be commissioned in the Dindigul and Tirunelveli district of Tamil Nadu by the end of March 2013.

Sri Kumarswamy Mineral Exports Private Limited has an existing installed capacity of 29.25 MW from wind energy projects solely developed by Suzlon, operating in sites across Karnataka, Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra.
