

# ■ India to add 4,300MW Wind Capacity in 2016-17: Tanti



**BHUUJ** India's wind power capacity is set to grow 30% or 4,300 MW in 2016-17, helped by capacity addition in Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat and

Madhya Pradesh, among others, said Suzlon Group chairman Tulsī Tanti. At present, the total wind power installed capacity in the country is around 27 GW, accounting for about 9% of India's total installed capacity. "India is a very promising and demanding market. It is set to grow by 30% annually. In 2016-17, the country will add about 4,300 MW of wind power," said Tanti. Speaking from Germany, Tanti said: "Most capacity will be added by Andhra Pradesh, followed by Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka, Rajasthan and Maharashtra. Some will be added in Tamil Nadu."
