India to add 4,300MW Wind Capacity in 2016-17: Tanti BHUJ India's wind power capacity

is set to grow 30% or 4,300 MW in 2016-17, helped by capacity addition in Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh, among others, said Suzlon Group chairman Tulsi Tanti. At present, the

country is around 27 GW, accounting for about 9% of India's total installed capacity. "India is a very promising and demanding market. It is set to grow by 30% annually. In 2016-17, the

total wind power installed capacity in the

country will add about 4,300 MW of wind power," said Tanti, Speaking from Germany, Tanti said: "Most capacity will be added by

Andhra Pradesh, followed by Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka, Rajasthan and Maharash-

tra. Some will be added in Tamil Nadu."
