

# Suzlon Group bags over 50 MW wind power project in Andhra Pradesh

New Delhi, November 28

Wind turbine maker Suzlon Group has bagged an over 50 MW wind power project in Anantapur, Andhra Pradesh.

Suzlon, a leading global re-

newable energy solutions provider, today announced winning this order from a "leading business house".

"The project consists of 24 units of S95 90m tubular tower with rated capacity of 2.1 MW,"

the company said in a BSE filing today. Located at Anantapur, Andhra Pradesh, the project is scheduled for completion in March 2017. This order win takes the current year's total order portfolio with the business

house to 84 MW, out of which 33.60 MW was announced earlier as a part of order wins from SMEs, it said.

Suzlon will provide comprehensive operation and maintenance for 20 years, and it in-

cludes dedicated lifecycle asset management services to the project.

The project has potential to provide power to over 27,000 households and reduce 0.10 million tonnes of CO2 emis-
