Suzlon bags order from ReNew Power

New Delhi, April 20 Renewable energy solution pro-

vider Suzlon Group today said it has bagged fifth order from Re-New Power Ventures for its 100.80 MW wind power project.

"Suzlon will install 48 units of their latest SIII 120m wind turbine generators (WTG) with a capacity of 2.1 MW in ReNew Power's Limbwas project in Madhya Pradesh," the company said in a statement.

This turnkey project for Suzlon is scheduled to be completed by March 2018. The project has the potential to provide power to over 54,000 households and reduce 0.20 million tonnes of CO2 emissions per annum.

With this order, Suzlon's portfolio with ReNew Power would exceed more than 600 MW, spanning across Gujarat, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Andhra Pradesh, it said.
